Soldering Sampler: Necklace

A cabochon stone of your choice. Round will be easiest to set, oval is OK too, free-form or with corners is less advisable if you are not experienced. Size should be between 10mm and 25mm.

Other materials you will need can be brought with you or purchased from the instructor:

- Sheet metal of your choice(s), especially silver and copper: 22 gauge is a good choice, 20 gauge is OK too for the silver; copper, brass or other accent materials can be down to 24 gauge.
- Bezel strip, fine silver, suitable for your stone. If in doubt, get it from the instructor
- Large-link chain, or wire to make it, 18 or 20 gauge sterling
- Any solder you have and wish to learn to use (wire, paste and powdered solder will be available to try—there will be a \$5 fee to cover solder costs)
- Note taking materials

Tools are all available in the studio, but feel free to bring your favorites.

Cost of materials depends on your design and the current cost of silver, but should not be more than \$30. Make checks payable to the instructor.
