### **Students should bring basic materials:**

- Paper
- Scissors
- White glue
- Pencils
- Ruler
- A tool box, shoe box, or whatever is convenient portable storage

ABSOLUTELY REQUIRED for writing on metal is the Sharpie brand ultra-fine marker in any color

WEAR OLD CLOTHES

Metalworking tools are provided, but if you already own the following bring them with your name clearly marked on them:

- Needle files
- 8" half-round files #0 and #2
- Jewelry pliers (half-round/flat, chain nose, flat/flat, and round/flat)
- Side or end cutters
- Rawhide mallet
- Planishing hammers
- Forming hammers, etc.

Supplies such as saw blades, silver, sanding sticks, stones, and findings will be paid for by each student on an individual as needed basis. Consumable materials supplied by the instructor such as solder, flux, etc will be assessed to all students as a materials fee.
