SUPPLY LIST

- small paint brushes (e.g., size 0, 1, 3)
- sketchbook or notebook
- small scissors (one that cuts well in small spaces)
- 4. high contrast black and white patterns/images that you may like to use for photo etch process. This can be copyright free images or something of your own design (I will provide lots of material you may use as well) Images should not be too large.
- 5. particulate respirator such as 3M 8210: masks that are recommended for sanding, grinding, sawing, sweeping, etc. and a zip lock bag to store it in. I will also have them available for purchase.
- 6. glue stick
- 7. copper in 22, 20 or 18 gauge you might have - there will be sheet copper and copper shapes available for purchase.

Note: If you want to work in silver, please email me ahead of time for more details.

A fee of approximately \$20.00 per student will cover the use of enamels and various enameling consumables and will be payable to the instructor at the end of class.

Metal and materials such as gold leaf and silver foil will be available for purchase from the instructor.
