### Think Slow, Paint Fast: Plein Air with Acrylics

This class will be using **Heavy Body Liquitex** which holds paint viscosity like oil paints.

The paint numbers are from the Liquitex paint chart and are meant for quick color identification.

154 Cadmium Red Medium  
161 Cadmium Yellow Medium  
160 Cadmium Yellow Light  
316 Phthalocyanine Blue  
317 Phthalocyanine Green (blue shade)  
170 Cobalt Blue  
110 Quinacridone Crimson  
127 Burnt Sienna  
276 Mars Black  
432 Titanium White \* get large tube or two tubes

Soft gel Matte (Golden Brand) tube or jar  
Soft gel Gloss (Golden Brand) tube or jar  
Acrylic Retarder in tube or jar  
optional small jar of white acrylic gesso  
optional Light Modeling Paste (Golden Brand)

Backpack or canvas tote to carry supplies

Portable standing Easel.

Box easels are fine.

Aluminum easels need to be weighted. \*Bring a plastic bag, old sock and some heavy wire to secure your easel.

Small plastic trash bag

Paper towels or rags

1/2" masking tape

Full Water bottle(s) for painting water. (About a liter.)Water needs to be transported to the site.

Two cottage cheese sized containers to hold water.

Spray bottle that allows misting and spraying.

Four paper clamps. Small hardware store clamps will work.

Canvas Boards or equivalent - 14 total

sizes 5" x 7" (six)

6" x 8" (three)

9" x 12" (three)

11" x 14" (two)

Plastic Palette Knife

Plastic palette or 12" white plate (we need a good mixing area)

Portable Sketchbook

9" x 12" Strathmore Bristol Pad (smooth)

Pencil No. 2

Brushes: Hogs bristle or blend

Two filberts #6 or #8

One round #4

Two Brights #6 and #2

Plastic wrap : Saran Wrap or similar brand

Large zip lock bag

Sponges : 1 1/2 " or 2" sponge brush is fine.

Kneaded eraser

Optional: Camera

General outdoor comforts

Insect repellent, Sunscreen, lip balm, Hat with brim, Portable Chair if needed. Drinking water.

Snacks, etc. Loose clothes, extra wrap if weather turns colder. Flat comfortable shoes, windbreaker, duct tape.
