**Drawing: The Next Step**

**Required Materials:**

- a drawing pad 14"x17" or larger (white bond paper, not newsprint)
- a kneaded eraser
- a white gum eraser (or similar)
- an 18" metal ruler (or larger)
- sand paper (for sharpening)
- a chamois cloth (or paper towels)
- a blending stump
- an battery powered (portable) pencil sharpener
- a drawing board with clips or a large rubber band

and your choice of any **monochromatic** drawing medium such as: (Choose one type or more)

- graphite pencils (at least 4 different levels of hardness i.e. **2H, HB, 2B** and **4B**)
- charcoal pencils (at least 3 different levels of hardness e.g. **HB, B, and 3B**)
- compressed charcoal sticks
- vine charcoal
- or any dark-value Nupastel drawing sticks such as black, gray, brown, maroon or bottle green.

**\*\*Please no colored pencil or colored pastel sets.**
