Sketch pad 11 x 14" or larger with 90lb or heavier paper

Tracing pad

2 B pencils

Kneaded eraser and another soft eraser (Sanford Magic Rub is a nice one)

1 medium blue pastel stick

Painters tape or any low adhesive masking tape

Portable water container

PENS such as:

Waterproof ink pens like Micron or Permawriter in the size tips you prefer,
preferably from fine to heavy weight.

1 Crowquill pen holder and several different size tips (Speedball has small sets of these)

1 bottle waterproof black India ink

or

if you prefer and you already have them, technical pens in various point sizes.

Either a small set of watercolors, watercolor pencils or colored pencils. (one of these items is sufficient) Prismacolor and Faber Castell are just a few of the nice pencil sets. Watercolor brushes in varying sizes, for instance #2 round, #4 round pointed, #6 round and #12 round or a 3/4 inch flat brush are all good choices if you intend to use watercolor.

Rags for cleaning up or tissue.

Ruler, t-square and triangle if you have them.

Portable chair or cushion

Easily transportable carrying case for all the above.

Whatever else you need for your comfort outside: insect spray, sunblock, drinking water, hat, etc.

I encourage students to bring the tools they already have and are comfortable working with, so if you already own pens or watercolors or colored pencils - bring those!
