**Absolutely essential supplies: I like the Liquitex or Golden brand**

Set of acrylic paints (10 to 12 colors) –including black & white

Alizarin Crimson (Red)	Hooker's Green Deep or med green	Purple
Cadmium Orange	Naples Yellow	Titanium White
	Lime Green	Mars Black

**OR Golden Brand**

Cad. Red Medium	Green Gold	Phthalo Green (YS)
Colbalt Blue	Hansa Yellow Medium	Pyrrole Orange
Colbalt Teal	Jenkins Green	Quinacridone Magenta
Dioxazine Purple	Mars Black	Titanium White

**Canvas** 24"X 30" (Fredrix Red Label is a good brand). If you paint fast bring two.

**Sketch book** 8X10 or 9X12 spiral bound – for planning ideas

**Brushes-** (Bigger is better)

2 or 3 synthetic oil/acrylic brushes filberts #0, #8, #10, #12, #14 & 1 round #16, #18, or #20

Do not buy hog bristle oil brushes

**Princeton Value (6) Pack Brush Set** for Acrylics & Watercolor for 11.95 is a good buy available at Artist Guild & Dick Blick.

-Old stiff brushes for scumbling (you want to be able to push with these brushes), borrow 2 or 3 old brushes from a painting friend if possible

-Pink Soap for cleaning brushes (buy at artist's store)

**Palette;** plastic or Styrofoam vegetable trays

**A mister** is a must to keep paints wet (buy at hardware store)

**Supplies from home**

-Sponge (small cut into 2" squares)

-Glad Press N'Seal to cover paints on palette

Paper toweling

-water container (like plastic cottage cheese box)
