Since students in this class have experience in Watercolor already, the following materials list is a suggestion of items to add to your usual supplies.

Supplies

- Several brushes. Suggested: Round #10, #6, #2, flat wash brush, scrubber.
- Spiral bound watercolor sketchbook approximately 8" x 10".
- Two sheets of 22" x 30" cold press 150 or 300 lb watercolor paper.
- Miscellaneous pencils, eraser, ruler, scissors, exacto knife, salt, water container, palette, sponge, paper towels, squirt bottle.
- Color wheel
- Folding chair (optional)
- Assorted pigments (suggested) Ultramarine Blue, Cobalt Blue, Burnt Sienna, Raw Sienna, Viridian, Hookers Green, Alizarin Crimson or Permanent Rose and Paynes Grey, and other favorites.
