- 1 -22x30 sheet of Arches Watercolor paper 140 lb or 300 lb
- pencil and eraser
- Winsor Newton watercolor tube paints, the majority should be transparent or semi-transparent
- Palette should contain:
 - A warm and cool of each primary color
- Sable brand watercolor brushes or synthetic:
 - #4 round
 - #8 round
 - #12 or #14 round
 - Please note: all rounds must have a good point on them. If you prefer using flats, you may use those too.
 - A stiff scrubber type brush to scrub out areas or mistakes
 - A cheap brush, about the size of a #4, to apply Frisket (a sticky masking material) if you have specialty tools for applying this, you may bring those too
- container for water
- paper towels
- masking tape
- masking fluid and brush
- Sealed container of liquid soap and water (50/50)
- I will supply the photos from which we will paint! (flowers)
