Imagination- sense of adventure. Bring whatever supplies you have or normally use. Do not go out and purchase special materials for this workshop—you are welcome to try anything I have.

- A zoomfinder (www.cheapjoes.com) or two small L shaped corners like mat samples
- Tracing paper, graphite transfer paper, and sketchbook (important), pencils, scissors, ruler
- Paint supplies- bring whatever you have or normally use in whatever media you choose, I will be using:
 - Paper- Arches 140# and 300# Cold Press, any will work
 - Boards- Gatorboard or some other paint board to work on
 - Paints- Windsor Newton, Daniel Smith, or M. Graham- Bring your favorite colors. Make sure you have a red, blue and yellow.
 - Brushes- 2" flat or Hake, selection of rounds (30, 12, 8, 6, 4) and flats (1", 1/2", 1/4"), scrubber, rigger, palette knife, pen knife or table knife. A pipette if you have one. A sponge.
 - Masking- pebeo or white mask are my favorites. Old brush to apply & rubber cement remover.
 - Palette- white tray or palette
 - Kleenex and paper towel
 - Water container, paper towels, tissues, saran wrap, waxed paper, masking tape, sponges, eraser, spray bottle, graphite transfer paper, white chalk
- Samples or slides of photographs of your personal work along with a resume if you have one. I will try to spend time with each student individually.
- Resource material: photos, sketches, items that interest you personally. You can already have them drawn if you prefer.
- If you plan to try pouring, please bring at least a couple of stretched half sheet watercolor paper soaked and stapled to board. You can draw on your dry prepared paper ahead of time if you like.

If you do not have or use masking, I will have small kits available at the workshop for \$20.00 that includes a small bottle of masking, a couple brushes, a remover, and a pipette.

I love to teach and am looking forward to our time together. We will have lots of fun and hopefully learn as well... Linda
